HOBBY HORSE

Requirements:

Sharp Pointed Scissors Fine Needle Dark Brown thread Alleens Tacky Glue Toothpicks Tweezers Opti-Visor or glasses



Kit Contents:

120mm - 3mm wide Ribbon 60 x 20mm Brown Ultra Suede 2 X 130mm White Ultra Suede Stained Toothpicks Batting 2 White beads, 6 Stars Sheepskin



40cm #100 DMC Cotton & Black cotton thread

- 1. Stitch head pieces (right side) together using whip stitch, from A to B leaving the end uncut. Fig.A
- 2. Stuff head firmly. Seeing that nose area is well shaped. Fig A1
- 3. Take ears & fold in half. At the base make a few little stitches to hold fold & then glue to head. Fig B
- 4. To make nostrils do two little french knots on either side of the head in black thread doubled. Fig C
- 5. The mouth is made by making a large stitch from side of the head to the centre seam & then repeat on the other side. Fig C
- 6. With black thread doubled, establish eye area & make a few stitches from side to side. Attach white bead & make a french knot, go back through head & repeat on the opposite side. Fig D
- 7. Apply some Aleens tacky to point of stick & push into the neck cavity, using left over thread slip stitch around end and pull tight. With cream cotton & holding tight wrap thread around neck pulling tight & working downwards until all the fabric has been covered, then end off & apply Aleens glue to secure the end. Fig E
- 8. Cut white ultra suede strapping into the following lengths:
 - 1 x 25mm
 - 1 x 35mm
 - 1 x 55mm


Use 35mm piece around the nose, 55mm piece from nose piece, around back of head down to meet on other side. Small piece from just below ears from one side to the other. Fig F


- 9. Stick mane on with tacky glue from just below the ears down the back. Fig G
- 10. Join satin ribbon from strapping just below ears to join on the other side. Stick stars on head straps to decorate. Fig G






